The other top seven DHS finishers were Sarah Hinton, 9th; 17:01; Hannah Lybbert, 12th, 17:13; Kiley Greiner, 19th, 17:29 and Jade Taylor, 21st, 17:34.

Teammates Vivian Lee (8th, 14:32) and Katrina Haws (9th, 14:32) ran together to top 10 finishes. Zoe Pritchard was the fastest frosh for the girls with her 13th place/14:49 effort. Keira Emmett (34th, 15:47) and Eliza Meyer (34th, 16:06) and Rebecca Chang (55th, 16:41) were the fifth-seventh place finishers for the team.
